If you're looking for something to do, Delano Lanes and Entertainment Center is a good place to look.

It offers everything from a full menu and happy hour specials to live music with no cover charge every weekend and, of course, bowling.

Delano Lanes and Entertainment Center is the place to go for local, live music. Shows begin at 9 p.m. and have recently featured bands such as DiamondBack, Shaw Brothers, and Tim Mahoney. When the warmer weather of summer returns, so will outdoor shows.

Acoustic music from a variety of local artists is offered on a regular basis, and Texas Hold 'Em poker takes place at 7:30 p.m. each Tuesday.

While enjoying a show, or getting ready for one, patrons can take advantage of drink specials and a full menu.

"We are committed to satisfying our customers with great food and excellent service," owner Lindsey Emery said. "We offer a wide variety of delicious dishes for lunch and dinner."

That menu includes homemade soups, salads, wraps, and sandwiches. But, it wouldn't be complete without its selection of burgers.

Lane 4 Burger, the Fire Burger, Elvis Burger, Juicy Lucy, Patti's Pizza Burger, and Buffalo Bleu Burger top the list as some of the crowd favorites.

ing appetizers like tempura shrimp; sides like parmesan garlic mashed potatoes and Caesar salads; and entrees like brandy glazed pork tenderloin and award-winning One Eye's smoked ribs. Catering is also

available for parties and other events.

Delano Lanes and Entertainment Center wouldn't be true to its name without bowling. Improvements include a complete resurface of all 12 lanes, new scoring system and flat-screen TVs in the bowling alley, and seven new flat-screen TVs in the bar. Automatic bumpers can also be programmed for bowlers who need them.

Bowling costs \$4 per game per person and shoe rental is available for \$2.

Families and kids are always welcome at Delano Lanes and Entertainment Center, which also looks for ways to give back to the community. Recently, Emery nominated Mt. Olive Lutheran School through the kids bowl free program and was awarded a \$1,000 grant for the school.

The lanes will host a turkey tournament at 7 p.m. Thanksgiving day, which will be a 7-8-9 no-tap tournament.

Prior to that event, the venue will host a Halloween party and costume contest Saturday, Oct. 29.

Emery has worked at the bowling alley for 10 years, dating back to when it was called Doc Holiday's.

She and her husband, Doug, went on to run the bowling alley. Doug has since opted to pursue other ventures. Doug and Lindsey have two children: 3-year-old Danielle and 8-week-old Liam.
